Applications are welcome from individuals with a range of expertise and knowledge of assessment or SoTL best practices from those who would like to learn more to those who are wellversed in one or more assessment or SoTL practice.

The principal purpose of the SoTL Fellowship program is for theo LFEllow(s) to work collaboratively with UARA and the SoTL FLC to explore, implement, and promote best practices in assessment or SoTL. Each SoTL Fellow will serve a oneyear term as a member of the SoTL FLC in the upcoming annual year and support UARA GULL Weelefforts, as needed. SoTL Fellows will present their project at the SU Spring Teaching and Learning Conference or adifferent venue as approved by the SoTL FLC. Each SoTL Fellow's project may be completed anytime between spring 2022 and fall 2022, including summer (as desired).
